Nominations must be received by FRIDAY, OCTOBER 29, 2010

In narrative form, please include the following information for the consideration. The nomination should not exceed five pages.

The criteria will be:

- Must be a member of, or work for an IPRA/IAPD member agency
- What environmental need (or cause) did the professional address within the agency or community?
- Describe the process or the problem solved.
- What special knowledge does the individual have and how did their knowledge or experience influence the outcome of their actions?
- How will the addressed issue outcome be sustained or was it a one-time action?
- Why is this person deserving of this award?

You may want to attach the following in support of the nomination:

- *Resume/Biographical Sketch*
- *Letters of Support*
- *Supportive news clippings, articles, etc.*
